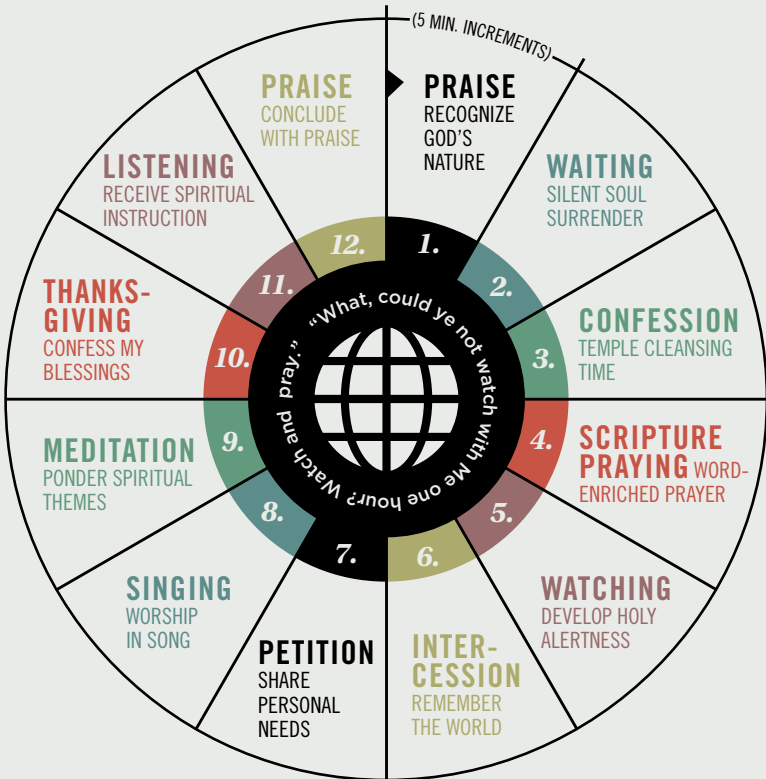
The number after each country gives the population in millions. “C.A.” designates Creative Access nations where the Gospel is restricted.

2 WAITING Silent Soul Surrender (Ps. 46:10)
3 CONFESSION Temple Cleansing Time (Ps. 139:23)
4 SCRIPTURE PRAYING Word-Enriched Prayer (Jer. 23:29)
5 WATCHING Develop Holy Alertness (Col. 4:2)
6 INTERCESSION Remember the World (1 Tim. 2:1-2)
7 PETITION Share Personal Needs (Matt. 7:7)
8 SINGING Worship in Song (Ps. 100:2)
9 MEDITATION Ponder Spiritual Themes (Josh. 1:8)
10 THANKSGIVING Confess My Blessings (1 Thess. 5:18)
11 LISTENING Receive Spiritual Instruction (Eccl. 5:2)
12 PRAISE Conclude with Praise (Ps. 52:9)

Father, I ask for OPEN HEARTS to embrace the Gospel. (2 CORINTHS 4:6)
Father, I ask for OPEN HEAVENS that the Gospel will transform nations. (ISAIAH 45:8)
